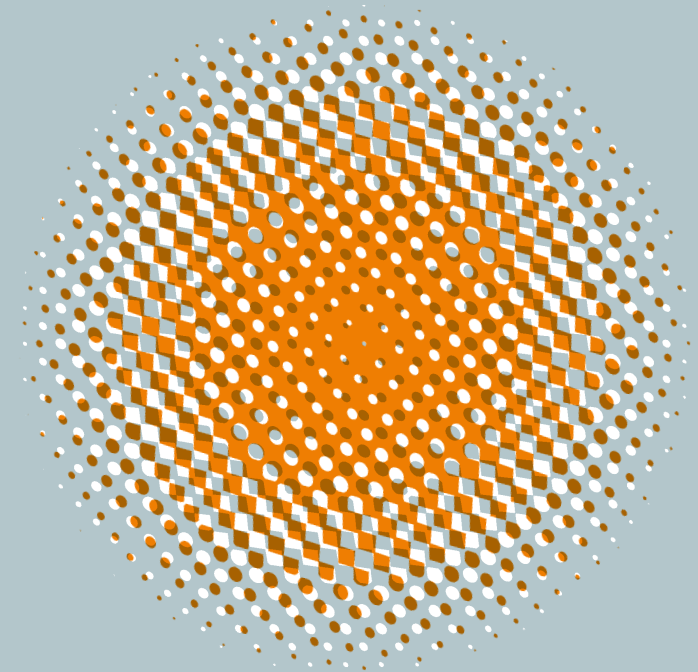

# THE TOPIC OF THE STUDY DAY

Group analysis is based on psychoanalysis, but it includes - in theory and technique - concepts which are different from psychoanalysis. Since the foundation of group analysis by S.H.Foulkes we can observe a variety of different developments in group analysis and in psychoanalysis. Group analysis has developed new concepts to understand destructivity; it works with a deeper understanding of defence mechanisms; and it opened the treatment up to a broader range of patients and clinical settings. In the field of psychoanalysis different perspectives emerged, such as narcissism, object relations, the linguistic approach and inter-subjectivity. The EGATIN Study Day 2016 will discuss these developments in psychoanalysis in relation to their influence on group analysis. The specific focus will be on the impact on training in group analysis. EGATIN defines in their 'essential training standards' various psychoanalytic basics, such as the personal and collective unconscious, mirroring, transference, counter-transference, projective identification and other projective processes, anxiety and defence, resistance and working through. The ways of teaching and learning these psychoanalytic basics differs amongst training institutions. Some of them require psychoanalytic training before group analytic training; some of them offer a comprehensive training including psychoanalytic skills. It can also be assumed that each training institution stresses particular concepts and it will be valuable to compare these different approaches. Accepting diversity in this respect it can be understood as the historical perspective of any given training institution. This would help to establish an open and creative space for thinking within EGATIN.
